Multi Skills Festival

Friday 6th November - Multi Skills focuses on the fundamentals of agility, balance and co ordination allowing all students to participate in a range of fun games and activities alongside other children from other primary schools. It also allows the students to experiment with different types of movement and explore sports in a new fun way.
